EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, chapter II Section 289 of the Local Government Code clearly states how local government unit shall have an equitable share in the proceeds derived from the utilization and development of the national wealth within their respective areas, including sharing the same with the inhabitants by way of direct benefits;

WHEREAS, the intent of the Electric Fund (EF) under the Energy Regulation (ER) 1-94 is to ensure the effective implementation of the reduction in cost of electricity in the communities where the source of energy is located, the mechanics and procedures prescribed in the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)-DOE Circulars No. 95-01 and 98-01 dated October 31, 1995 and September 30, 1998, respectively and other issuances related thereto shall be pursued;

WHEREAS, an Electric Subsidy Scheme is adopted to provide assistance to electric consumers for the purpose of reduction in the cost of electricity as mandated by the Local Government Code and the Republic Act 136;

WHEREAS, the rate for the Electric Subsidy is directly tied to the level of electric generation by the Tiwi Geothermal Power Plants which dictates the amount to be received by consumers depending on the fund available as power generation increase or decrease;

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO: 2019-2

(AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE NEW ELECTRIC SUBSIDY SCHEME FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIWI, AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF, AUTHORIZING THE FUNDING THERETO AND OTHER AUTHORITIES RELATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF)

SECTION 1. This ordinance shall be known as the Electric Subsidy Ordinance of 2021.

- SECTION 2. It shall be the rule of the Municipality of Tiwi, Albay to sustain the provision of electric subsidy from the proceeds covering the Electric Fund (EF) under the Energy Regulation (ER) 1-94 to ensure the effective implementation of the reduction in cost of electricity in the host communities where the source of energy is located.
- SECTION 3. It shall be policy of the Municipality of Tiwi, Albay to increase the electric subsidy to all residential household consumers in the entire municipality to One Hundred Pesos (Php) 100.00) per month;
- **SECTION 4.** It shall be the rule of the Municipality of Tiwi, Albay to release the said electric subsidy to household consumers through the respective barangays covering the consumers every other four months.
- SECTION 5. The Municipality of Tiwi, Albay and the concerned recipient Barangay, represented by their Punong Barangay shall execute a Memorandum of Agreement relative to the provision of the electric subsidy to all household consumers within the barangay.
- **SECTION 6.** The recipient Barangay shall withdraw, dispense and liquidate the fund downloaded to them subject to the usual accounting system, rules and procedures.
- **SECTION 7.** All other ordinances who are in contrary to this ordinance is hereby repealed and/ or modified accordingly.
